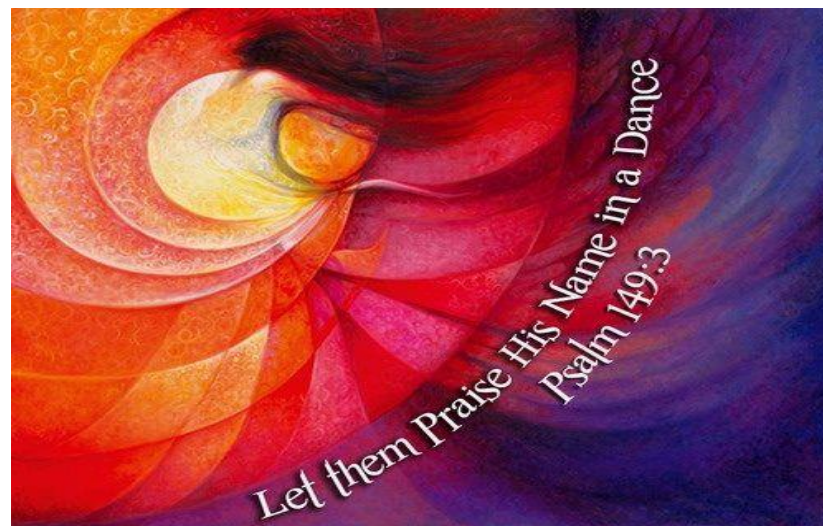

**COVID 19 Marshals** The South Australian government has declared that from this Friday, August 21st, 2020 that all churches will need to appoint a **COVID Marshal**. What this means for churches is that for worship services and related food/hospitality service, there must be a COVID Marshal present and easily identifiable. Their role is to Promote and take practical steps to ensure people participating in operations are complying with density requirements and physical distancing principles
