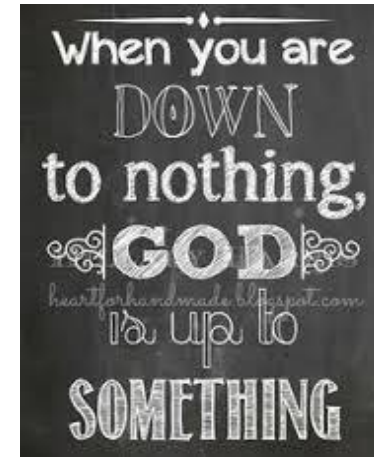
COVID 19 Marshals
